Personal Accident Cover

In respect of death or injury caused by accidental, external and violent means whilst training for, competition in, or demonstrating martial arts.

Permanent Total Disability	£50,000
Temp. Total Disability	£50/week up to 52 weeks
* Excludes under 16s	(Excluding first 14 days)
Additional Travel Expenses (In the event of Temp. Total Disability)	Up to £25/week – Max 52 weeks
Broken Bones:	
Leg, Arm, Collar or Cheek	£50 (Max. per person £150)
Finger, Thumb or Toe	£ 5 (Max. per person £15)
Hospitalisation	£25/day (Max. £750)
Rehabilitation/Retraining (In the event of Permanent Total Disability)	Up to £1,000
